1	SD-INT03 (Student has a transfer EPC with a STU-PRIOR-ED of 16 or 17)	Students who declared having a previously earned degree at admission (i.e., PriorEd = 16, associate's or 17, bachelor's and above) and have a transfer program EPC (based on the Admissions application) will be coded Y.
2	SD-INT05 (Student has a transfer EPC and STU-PRIOR-ED is not equal to 16 or 17)	Students who indicate a transfer program of study and who do not declare having a previously earned degree at admission (PriorEd <> 16, associate's and <> 17, bachelor's and above) will be coded A.
3	SD-INT04 (Student has A intent, transfer EPC, STU-PRIOR-ED is not 16 or 17 and 30 or more cumulative credits earned.	Students who indicate a transfer program of study and who do not declare having a previously earned degree at admission (i.e., PriorEd <> 16, associate's and <> 17, bachelor's and above) and have earned 30 credits will be coded B.
4	SD-INT06A (looks for stu-plan-work GT 12) & SD-INT06B (looks for stu-plan-attend not equal to 15)	Students with a transfer EPC other than 1201, Undecided; 2500, AAGS; or 2502, Personal/Professional Development - Non-degree seeking and who have no prior degree (i.e., PriorEd <> 16, associate's and <> 17, bachelor's and above) and who do not plan to earn a degree (PlanAttend <>15 or is null and PlanWork >12 or is null) are coded L.
5	SD-INT07A & SD-INT07B	Students who are pursuing the AAGS (EPC = 2500) degree and who have no prior degree (i.e., PriorEd <> 16, associate's and <> 17, bachelor's and above) and plan to earn a BC degree or certificate (Stu-Plan-Work = 11 or 12 or PlanAttend = 15) are coded A. (These students will never change Intent unless they leave the AAGS program.)
6	SD-INT14	Students in Running Start (fee-pay-status 50 or 54) are coded Y
7	SD-INT09N	College in the High School students (fee-pay-status 62) are coded Y

8	SD-INT17	All students in ALDAC (437) and OLS (887) programs are coded F
9	SD-INT16N	Students coded in the 70's or 80's on the STU-WORK-ATTND field and enrolled in a non-selective admissions prof-tech EPC are coded F
10	SD-INT12N	Students enrolled with a selective admissions EPC are coded G. [Students admitted to the program will be changed to F in a later step.]
11	SD-INT13N	All students enrolled with a prof-tech EPC who still have the X intent are coded G
12	SD-INT10A & SD-INT10B	Students who indicate they plan to earn a BC degree or certificate (Stu-Plan-Work = 11 or 12 or PlanAttend = 15) and who have a valid non-selective admissions professional-technical program EPC are coded F . (steps a and b)
13	SD-INT15N	Students admitted to selective admissions prof-tech programs (via test score screen) are coded F.
14	SD-IF734	Students with the 734 (Interior Design) EPC who have completed INDES 170 are coded F (old gateway model)
15	SD-INT11A	Students who are in basic skills level courses and no other types of courses are coded E. (Alternative source would be StuType = 5.) (current datax uses STU-TYP = 5)
16	SD-INT11B	Students (who are still coded X) with the Parent Education EPC (010) are coded intent K
