<b>A—Academic Non-Transfer Degree</b>	
<p>Students who do not have a Prof-tech EPC <u>AND</u> have less than 30 credits earned <u>AND</u> do <u>not</u> have a previously earned degree based on Prior Education.</p> <p>Students pursuing the AAGS who also indicate they plan to earn a BC degree or certificate will be coded A, and will never change unless they change programs.</p>	<p>For the IPEDS Graduation Rate Survey cohort, of those with A Intent, <u>only</u> those who also have a Planned Length of Attendance = 15 will be captured as a member of the GRS cohort.</p> <p>Notes: EPC = Educational Program Code Planned length of attendance = 15 is defined as "Long enough to complete a degree"</p>
<b>B—Academic transfer</b>	
<p>Students who do not have a Prof-tech EPC and have earned 30 credits <u>AND</u> do <u>not</u> have a previously earned degree based on Prior Education</p>	<p>Students will be represented in the IPEDS Fall Enrollment as degree-seeking. They will <i>not</i> be in the GRS cohort of first-time, full-time degree-seeking students.</p>
<b>D—High School Diploma/GED Certificate (pre-college courses)</b>	
<p>Not used in this process.</p>	<p>Note: Should we consider putting students enrolled exclusively in GED courses in this code? [ we are not currently doing this ]</p>
<b>E—Developmental</b>	
<p>Students who are enrolled exclusively in ABE or GED or ESL or ELIUP or ELISP courses. [Determined by students enrolled with STU-TYP 5]</p>	<p>Note: Does <b>NOT</b> include students in postsecondary developmental math and English courses.</p>

<b>F—Vocational Preparatory (Approved EPC required)</b>	
<p>1. All students accepted into a special admissions program.</p> <p>2. Students in Interior Design with EPC = 734 <i>and</i> have transcribed INDES 170 course.</p> <p>3. Worker Retraining and Workfirst students who are not applicants for a selective admissions program.</p> <p>4. All ALDAC and Venture students</p> <p>5. Students who indicate they plan to earn a BC degree in a professional-technical program.</p>	<p>Better accuracy as these students <b>MUST</b> be F Intent.</p> <p>Note: Students <b>MUST</b> have the appropriate EPC code.</p>
<b>G—Vocational Preparatory, Applicant (Approved EPC required)</b>	
All students taking courses toward acceptance into a special admissions program, including Worker Retraining and Workfirst, and CEO.	Note: Students <b>MUST</b> have the appropriate EPC code.
<b>H—Vocational Apprentice (Valid EPC required)</b>	
None at BC	None
<b>J—Upgrading job skills--Vocational Supplemental (Valid EPC required)</b>

<b>K—Vocational Home and Family Life (Valid EPC required)</b>
