Student Intent Update Process @ Bellevue College

History

- “Gateway” course method
 - Students in prof/tech programs take a certain “gateway” course → F intent
 - Students in transfer programs: < 30 credits → A intent, >30 credits → B intent
- Utilized job scheduling to post intent
 - UU0805J

Problems

- Keeping gateway courses up-to-date was a challenge
- Transfer programs & students who already have a degree
- Too few prof/tech students with F intent
- How the HP stores student enrolled program and intent (SM700A & SM5001)

Changes...

- No longer based on gateway
- Looks at how students answer:
 - STU-PURP-ATTND, STU-PLAN-ATTND, STU-PRIOR-EDUC
- Still lots of DATAXs, but a cleaner process
- Benefits from improved student enrolled program codes:
 - New process where students confirm program of study when registering online

How it works...in a nutshell

- Use DATAX to identify students
 - Criteria are up to you...the gateway method might work for you
- Run job UUo8o5J (Student Intent Update)
 - Specify the subfile saved from DATAX
 - Specify intent for the students saved in that subfile
- Keep in mind that this updates SM700A (STU-YRQ-M) and may not update SM5001 (ie, the intent will not automatically carry over to the next quarter)
